

2020 Annual Report

Mission Statement

To support the Norfolk Animal Care and Adoption Center in sheltering and caring for Norfolk's stray and homeless animals, to promote and facilitate adoptions, to assist with special medical care, to promote and support spay/neuter in the community, and to educate the public about responsible pet ownership.

Friends of Norfolk Animal Care Center Programs, Events, and Community Outreach

Adoptions Program: Subsidized four large events, resulting in 247 adoptions.

Golden Paws Program: Subsidized discounted adoption rates for senior animals and senior adults (over the age of 65), resulting in 57 adoptions, and partnered with Animal Eye Care to offer free eye exams for pets adopted through the Golden Paws Program.

Medical Assistance Program: Provided funding for 500 animals to receive special medical treatments, making them healthy and adoptable. Medical treatments included cranial cruciate ligament surgery, mass removal, limb and tail amputations, mastectomy, cystotomy, cherry eye repair, entropion bilateral and unilateral repair, ocular enucleation, biopsies, diagnostic tests, full blood panels, senior blood panels, and heart worm treatments.

Spay/Neuter Program: Subsidized 12 clinics in Norfolk Neighborhoods, spaying or neutering 300 animals (163 cats and 137 dogs), 171 rabies vaccinations, and 231 microchips.

NACC Support Program: Provided funding for special supplies and equipment to help with animal care and adoptions, including elevated kuranda dog beds, a cat tower, benches and a new shed for our Pet Pantry Program.


Pet Pantry Program: We served 13 families, 25 animals, and distributed 6,000 lbs. of food.

Fundraising Events and Community Outreach:


- 6th Annual Dogtoberfest: Provided dogs and humans with a fun-filled day that raised spirits, awareness, and \$1,149.
